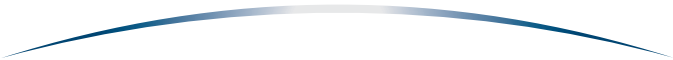

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HOW WE CHARGE FOR OUR SERVICES

All fees and commissions are inclusive of GST and the fees may be higher than those disclosed below in complex cases. In these instances, we will inform you of the exact fee payable promptly in writing.

SCHEDULE OF FEES

Type of Advice	Fee Charged
Initial consultation	At our expense.
Initial advice (advice preparation and implementation)	An advice preparation fee will range from \$2,200 to \$6,600 depending on the level of complexity of your situation and the advice provided. This is a one-off cost and is payable even in the event you decide not to proceed with our advice.
Fixed term advice service	Kings Park Securities' Adviser Service Fee (ASF) is determined on a percentage sliding scale basis, based on the combined value of funds managed by Kings Park Securities and is reviewed annually. For a combined value of funds up to \$1,000,000 the percentage-based fee is 1.25% per annum. For funds over this amount a sliding scale fee basis applies. For example, based on an initial investment valued at \$500,000, our standard Adviser Service Fee would be 1.25% per annum or \$6,250 per annum. In comparison; based on an initial investment valued at \$1,500,000, our standard Adviser Service Fee would be 1.16% per annum or \$17,400 per annum. A minimum initial investment portfolio balance applies. Note: the flat percentage fee will be applied to the fluctuating balance of your portfolio each month.
Ad hoc advice	The fees for the provision of ad hoc advice not covered by the fixed term advice service arrangement will be charged on an hourly basis at a rate of \$275. Additional services and fees not covered by the fixed term advice service arrangement are as follows: • Centrelink Liaison Service: \$550 per annum • Estate Planning Facilitation Service: up to \$275 facilitation fee • Plus, legal costs (to be determined by our preferred third-party legal professional, based on complexity) Note: these services are only available as an additional service to the fixed term - advice service arrangement mentioned above.
Insurance products	We will receive commission for our initial and ongoing services to you. Initial commission is between 0% and 66% and the ongoing commission is between 0% and 33% of the annual premium and is paid by the insurance product issuer to us.

Where we are not confident that a conflict can be effectively managed, we will not proceed but will refer you to another provider.
